What to bring to After School Dance Registration

1. Completed Registration Form indicating which class you are registering for.
2. Completed Information Card
3. Check for the correct amount filled out to PHS with "Dance Class" in the memo.

Frequently Asked Questions:

1. I'm planning on trying out for a sport; can I still do after school dance?

Yes, we want to support all the things you do during your time at Presentation. On the registration form, write in the sport and season. Make sure you communicate with the teacher to let her know when it is time for you to start attending practices and missing dance.

2. Do I have to perform in the Spring Dance Concert?

No. Classes are general until the 6weeks prior to the concert when we start rehearsing for the performance in May. While performing is encouraged, it is not mandatory.

3. Are there extra practices for the concert?

Yes, there will be a few mandatory rehearsals the week before the concert. These dates can be found on the important date's page.

4. On early dismissal days (collaboration last), do we start class earlier?

No. Collaboration needs to be kept open for meetings and make up work. Class will always be at the assigned times.

5. Can I take only one semester of dance?

Yes, you must sign up at the beginning of the school year no matter what semester you will take the class to save your spot in the class. If at the beginning of the Spring semester you would like to take a class, please see the teacher to see if there are any available spots in the class.

6. Are classes year round?

Yes, classes are year round. You will only need to sign up and pay one time at the beginning of the school year to take classes both semesters. You do not need to re-sign up for the second semester.

7. Are the fee's per class or per semester?

The class fee is a onetime fee for the entire year. You will not need to pay any more than the onetime fee at the beginning of the school year.

Class Descriptions

Jazz I- For the students interested in the basics of dance and movement. Little to no dance experience is necessary. This class will perform at the Spring Dance Concert.

Jazz II/III- This class is for the students interested in improving jazz technique, flexibility and strength through a fast paced class. Jazz or ballet experience is necessary. This class is a continuation of Jazz I, a fast paced and challenging class. This class will perform at the Spring Dance Concert.

Advanced Performance Jazz- This class is a fast paced jazz technique class. This class is for the student who has had extensive dance training and is looking at improving on intermediate and advanced jazz skills adding in the element of performance. This class will be performing at the Winter Cabaret and the Spring Dance Concert. This class enrollment needs to be approved by Sara Fugate

Lyrical- This class combines foundation of all dance technique with lyrical movement. This class is for the students interested in the grace and style of ballet while interpreting the music through movement. This class is great for improving strength, balance and flexibility. This class will perform at the Spring Dance Concert.

Hip Hop- For the students who desire more of a street style. Emphasis is on attitude and style. This class will perform at the Spring Dance Concert.

Tap- This class is for the students with little to no tap experience. This class will be traditional tap with emphasis on rhythm and technique. This class will perform at the Spring Dance Concert.
